APRIL 22, 2019 ORDINANCE COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

Pursuant to due call and notice thereof, a meeting of the Ordinance Committee was held Monday, April 22, 2019 at the Municipal Building, 800 Borner St. Prescott, WI 54021

Aldersperson Hintz called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. Members present were Bailey Ruona and Galen Seipel. City Administrator Jayne Brand represented staff.

Ruona/Hintz motion to approve the minutes for April 1, 2019 passed without a negative voice vote.

Tented carports were discussed. The committee reviewed a proposed ordinance for tented carports. There was discussion regarding what would be allowed in a carport. Aldersperson Seipel stated the city should not regulate what is put in a carport since we don't regulate what is put in any other accessory structure or garage. Aldersperson Seipel & Ruona did not feel a building permit should be required to put up the structure but that it should meet all of the setback requires of the accessory structure ordinance. There can only be one of these type of structures on a property. City staff was directed to put together an ordinance and email to members so it can be presented at the May 13th Council meeting.

Discussion was held on boulevards and terrace. The main issue which was discussed was the material and products which are being stored by Edge Builders. After discussion the committee was of the consensus to allow Edge Builders to blacktop the boulevard for vehicle parking provided they store material and products close to their buildings.

Off street parking restrictions which currently limit the parking to two (2) one ton trucks was discussed. It was felt there are trucks which are over the one ton limit. The committee wants to change the ordinance to three tons.

Hintz/Ruona motion to adjourn passed without a negative voice vote.
