Call to order/Roll Call: Bill Fetzner called the meeting to order at 6:30. Members present were Bill Fetzner, Neil Riley, Mark Pierce and Cheri Johnson. Also present was Chief Eric Michaels.

Riley/Pierce motioned to approve minutes for December 5, 2018 and Pierce 2nd. Passed unanimously.

Chief Michaels discussed with Commission about 2 incidents that happened last week.

All Commissioners now have the Outlines for Hearing Procedures and will go through these procedures at a later date.

Riley/Pierce motioned to go into closed Session Wisconsin Stats. 19.85 (1) (c) - Considering employment, promotion, compensation or performance evaluation data of any public employee over which the governmental body has jurisdiction or exercises responsibility – Police Officer Hiring. Passed unanimously via roll call vote.
