

**CITY OF PRESCOTT, WISCONSIN
FEBRUARY 25, 2010 ORDINANCE COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES**

Pursuant to due call and notice thereof, a meeting of the Ordinance Committee was held Thursday, February 25, 2010 at the Municipal Building, 800 Borner St.

Chairperson Mark Huber called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m. Members present were Mark Huber, Marissa Holst and Peter Kelly. Fire Chief Bill Dravis and Zoning Administrator Jayne Brand represented staff. Also present City Attorney Terry Dunst.

Holst/Kelly motion to approve the minutes for February 10, 2010 passed without a negative voice vote.

Chairman Huber asked if there was any more discussion regarding possible changes to Section 7-6-1 (d) (4) regulation and licensing of fireworks in regards to storage distance. Alderperson Kelly questioned the fire chief if his recommendation for storage from a dwelling is 500 feet from building to building. Chief Dravis stated that is his recommendation. The staff recommended the following language change to the ordinance: (4) Storage Distance. No wholesaler, dealer or jobber may store fireworks in any building, structure, storage container of any kind, or outdoors, if the fireworks are within five hundred (500) feet of a dwelling, or if the building, structure or storage container is within five hundred (500) feet of a dwelling. **Holst/Kelly motion to close public discussions on Section 7-6-1 (d) (4) regulation and licensing of fireworks in regards to storage passed without a negative voice vote.**

Holst/Kelly motion to approve new language to Section 7-6-1 (d) (4) as recommended by staff in their memo of February 24, 2010 passed without a negative voice vote.

Kelly/Holst motion to recommend to council approval of Section 7-6-1 (d) (4) Storage Distance. No wholesaler, dealer or jobber may store fireworks in any building, structure, storage container of any kind, or outdoors, if the fireworks are within five hundred (500) feet of a dwelling, or if the building, structure or storage container is within five hundred (500) feet of a dwelling passed without a negative voice vote.

Kelly/Holst motion to adjourn passed without a negative voice vote.
