

CITY OF PRESCOTT, WISCONSIN
May 8, 2023 HEALTH & SAFETY COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

Pursuant to due call and notice thereof, a meeting of Health & Safety Committee was held Monday, May 8, 2023 at 800 Borner St., Prescott, WI 54021.

1. Call to Order/Roll Call: Meeting was called to order by Chair Dar Hintz at 5:00 PM. Members present were Dar Hintz, Maureen Otwell and Lindsey Owens. City Administrator Matt Wolf and Police Chief Eric Michaels represented staff.

2. Approval of Health and Safety Committee Minutes March 13, 2023

Committee Member Otwell motioned to approve the minutes from March 13, 2023, which was seconded by Committee Member Owens. Motion passed unanimously by voice vote (3-to-0).

3. Prescott Daze Detour – USH10-CTHQQ-STH35

The Committee reviewed the Prescott Daze Detour and discussed the new route. Chief Michaels stated that Sheriff Koranda approved the bypass and that the County has given an estimate of between \$1,500 to \$2,000 for the cost of putting up the signage. The Prescott Daze committee prefers this route as opposed to moving the Prescott Daze events along the Riverfront.

Committee Member Hintz approved recommending the new bypass route to Council along with splitting the costs of the bypass route with the Prescott Daze Committee. Otwell seconded the motion; motion passed unanimously by voice vote (3-to-0).

4. Kinnickinnic Street Line Stripping and Delineator Posts

The Committee discussed putting in from the northeast of the intersection of Elm Street and Kinnickinnic Street to the southwest of the intersection of Kinni and Flora Street. This would consist of a solid white line on each side with a solid yellow centerline. Additionally, the Committee discussed the intersection of Kinni and Flora having a crosswalk. To further slow traffic it is proposed that delineator posts are installed to create a “bump out” that would further slow traffic at this intersection.

Committee Member Hintz approved line stripping along Kinnickinnic Street and delineator posts at the Kinnickinnic Street and Flora Street intersection. Owens seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously by a voice vote (3-to-0).

5. Public Comment: None

6. Other Business: The Committee discussed the current personnel situation within the Police Department with Chief Michaels. Currently there are three open Police Officer positions.

7. Adjournment: Committee Member Otwell made a motion to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Committee Chair Hintz. Motion passed unanimously (3-to-0); meeting adjourned at 5:31.
