Mowing has started at the cemetery. Three employees have been hired by the city and will be paid by the city but the cemetery board will reimburse them. The city has purchased two zero turn mowers for the cemetery.

Isreal Haas of Freedom Park presented to the Board possible trails through the cemetery to get to Pine Coulee. The Board asked for additional information on the trails before a decision is made.

There is a large pine tree which needs to be removed. A large portion was blown down and is now a safety hazard. Rivertown Tree Service will be contacted to removed.

We will continue to work on getting all of the cemetery records electronically.

The city has done a mill and overlay on the blacktop at the cemetery
