

CITY OF PRESCOTT, WISCONSIN
AUGUST 8, 2022 ORDINANCE COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

Pursuant to due call and notice thereof, a meeting of the Ordinance Committee was held Monday August 8, 2022 at the Municipal Building, 800 Borner St. Prescott, WI 54021

Aldersperson Ruona called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m. Members present were Tom Oss and Bailey Ruona. Dar Hintz was excused City Administrator Matt Wolf and City Clerk Jayne Brand represented staff.

Oss/Ruona motion to approve the minutes for April 11, 2022 passed without a negative voice vote.

City Clerk Jayne Brand presented the proposed exceptions for UTV. The exceptions are for Halloween, Prescott Daze (the parade only by parade personnel), the ATVs, four-wheel utility vehicles can pull trailers at 5mph or less and all passengers must be seated while it is in motion, must have all lights in working order and on while in operation, no alcoholic beverages (because this meets the definition of a motor vehicle). Snow plowing will be allowed but must have activated flashing yellow light visible for 360 degrees. Liability insurance shall be provided to the city for anyone allowed these exceptions. The committee didn't know how the city would enforce the liability insurance since no application would be required for the exception.

Ruona/Oss motion to recommend approval of Ordinance 06-22 “Golf Cart Registration (H) Disqualified Vehicles” passed without a negative voice vote. The discussion on golf carts will be held at the next ordinance meeting.

The committee discussed passes at the boat launch should be displayed. The ordinance addition is as follows:

The annual pass shall be displayed on the boat trailer. The daily pass shall be displayed face up, with time and date visible in the windshield of the vehicle. Any owner or operator failing to pay the required fee and display the annual or daily pass shall be subject to a forfeiture as provided in § 1-4 of this Code.

Aldersperson Ruona asked that the ordinance include the location of the pass in the ordinance.

Oss/Ruona motion to recommend Ordinance 07-22 “Boat Launch Regulations” passed without a negative voice vote.

Discussion was held on council committees. It was discussed that Public Works and Parks and Public Property be combined. Ordinance Committee and License committee could be removed. Aldersperson Oss asked for some time to think this over.

The committee discussed goat buckthorn removal. There have been requests by residents to have goats in to remove the buckthorn. The committee is in favor of having an ordinance so staff was directed to work on an ordinance.

The beach and non-motorized boat launch parking signs are in. The posting of hours for the public beach has been completed.

Oss/Ruona motion to adjourn passed without a negative voice vote.
