**Fetzner/Riley motion to go into closed session per Wisconsin Stats. 19.85 (1) (c) -Considering employment, promotion, compensation, or performance evaluation data of any public employee over which the government body has jurisdiction or exercises responsibility- Interviews for Police Officers. Passed without a negative voice vote.**

**Riley/Fetzner motion to go into open session passed without a negative voice vote.**

**Fetzner/Riley motion that candidate was acceptable as new hire pending background check and physical. Passed without a negative voice vote.**

**Chief Michaels gave a brief update on the Police Department.**

**Calls for service so far this year are at 4016 as compared to 3918 last year at this time and he is technically down 4 officers.**

**The 2 officers on F.T.O. are progressing well.**

**Law Enforcement Agencies are competing for quality candidates and are coming up with creative programs to attract candidates to their agencies. Prescott needs to join those agencies in coming up with ideas or programs to entice quality people to our city.**

**K-9 Caesar and Officer Neely are in training and Caesar is doing very well**

**It was discussed that the Commission needs to establish a policy and procedure manual so there is consistency and a written guide for the current and future members to follow.**
